### Proposed move to new premises & branch modernisation

I'm writing to let you know that we are proposing to move the above Post Office branch next door to its current location to Tesco Stores, 92-93 Forest Walk, Halton Lea, Runcorn, WA7 2GX. I am also pleased to tell you that when the branch moves it will change to one of our new-look main branches.

The operator who currently runs the branch has resigned and the premises will no longer be available for Post Office use so the branch will be closing at its current location on Saturday 14 September 2013. We have therefore been working hard locally to identify a new location from which to operate the branch and to avoid any disruption in services to our customers.

I'm therefore pleased to tell you that an opportunity has arisen to move this branch into Tesco Stores, enabling us to offer improved Post Office facilities to customers. The Post Office counter area will be located to the rear of the store which currently houses stationery goods and a storage area. Tesco are planning to completely refit this area and re-align a number of internal fixtures and fittings to provide additional space to incorporate a modern six position open plan branch. The new branch opening times will be greatly extended in line with store opening times, with staffing aligned accordingly to customer demand.

The change to this branch is part of a three-year investment and support programme, the largest in the history of Post Office Ltd, which will see around 6,000 branches (about half the Post Office network) converting to new style branches.

### Consulting on the proposed change

As I have said we're working hard to avoid any disruption to Post Office services so we're aiming to open the new branch on Monday 16 September 2013. While this means we have made the decision to move the branch we would still welcome your views on the service offer at the new location. Therefore we're now commencing a local public consultation and before we finalise our plans would like to hear your views, particularly around the following questions:

- Are the new premises easy for you to get into and is there easy access inside?
- Do you have any concerns about the new location?
- If so, do you have any suggestions that could help us make it better for you?
- Are there any local community issues which you think could be affected by the proposed move?
- Is there anything you particularly like about the proposed change?

I've enclosed an information sheet that provides more details about the new location. If you have any comments or questions, please email or write to me via our Communication and Consultation team, whose contact details are below. Please note that your comments will not be kept confidential unless you expressly ask us to do so by clearly marking them "In Confidence". Any information we receive will be considered as we finalise our plans for the new branch. Other people in your organisation may be interested in this proposal, so please let them know about it.

Posters and leaflets will now be displayed in branch to let customers know about the changes and to ask their views. I've included information about the Code of Practice over the page and copies of the Code will also be available in branch.
